The Adoption Resource Network at Hillside Children's Center (ARN) provides opportunities for youth and families to learn about pre or post adoption resources through quality educational programs, referrals to medical, mental health and other service providers. Advocacy and other support services are also available.

ABOUT THE SERVICE

Specific programs offered include:

- Monthly information meetings -- "Step One," an overview of the process of adoption at Hillside Children's Center
- Monthly homestudy class -- 6-hour class that prepares individuals and couples for adoptive parenting
- International and Domestic Adoption --preparation/training, home studies, post-placement visits, adoption finalization reports, coordination of services with placement agency
- Adoption of Waiting Children -- preparation/training, home studies, post-placement visits, adoption finalization reports, coordination of services with placement agency
- Birth Mother Support -- pre- and post-pregnancy counseling; assistance in identifying potential adoptive families; service coordination for medical, legal and other services needed; temporary foster care for infants; 24-hour crisis response for women choosing to make an adoption plan
