Day Habilitation Services (Day Hab), of the Developmental Disabilities Services Program, provide person-centered opportunities in the community for life-skills enhancement. Day Hab Services assist people who want help improving independent living skills or developing volunteer, leisure, social, or recreation opportunities for themselves.

ABOUT THE SERVICE

Hillside staff work with each person to develop a person-centered, individualized plan to assist the person to acquire, retain, or improve their self-help, socialization, and adaptive skills, through community inclusion. Goal areas may include relationship building, self-advocacy, informed choice, communication, travel, and other areas in adult education.

People choose the type of work and sites throughout Monroe County they would like to access to promote their independent living goals. Hillside provides several locations as a "home base" to start and end the day, and the participants contribute to their communities through volunteer work and accessing community resources from there.

The Hillside interdisciplinary team includes the Day Hab Supervisor, Skillbuilders, a Behavior Specialist, Nursing, a Clinical Director, and the Program Director.
